Spectrum Generations Receives \$1,500 Grant for March for Meals

Campaign

(Augusta, August 5th 2008) Spectrum Generations, formerly Senior Spectrum announced today that it has been awarded a \$ 1,500 grant from the Meals on Wheels Association of America (MOWAA) in recognition of the success of its 2008 March for Meals campaign. The grant was announced by MOWAA in July, and the grant money will be awarded in August at the 2008 MOWAA Annual Conference in Pittsburgh, PA.

Spectrum Generations, March For Meals event included mayors, town managers and Maine's First Lady packing and delivering meals on wheels.

March for Meals is an annual national campaign to raise awareness of senior hunger and to encourage action on the part of the local community.
