Medicare Savings Program

The Cost of your Medicare part B premium is now \$104.90 a month. This payment is typically taken out of your Social Security check before you receive it. There is a federal program called the Medicare Savings Program that, if you qualify, will make this payment for you each month. The income and asset limits for this program are below. If you fall within these guidelines and would like to apply for this program, please call Spectrum Generations at (800) 639-1553 for assistance.

Single person: Monthly income must be below \$1,792.00 a month with less than \$50,000 in total cash assets.*

Married couple: Combined monthly income must be below \$2,424.00 with less than \$75,000 in total cash assets.*

*Cash assets include money in the bank, value of stocks & bonds, CD's, or anything that can be turned into cash (your home and car do not count). Call us today for assistance with applying for this benefit; you could start saving over \$100.00 per month!


