Caregiver Respite Program Funds Available!



Are you caring for someone with Dementia? Do you need a break? The Caregiver Respite Program can help. We can reimburse you for 80% of what it costs for several hours of adult day care or in-home care, up to \$3,040 a year. In witten order to qualify, the care recipient must have a written

diagnosis of a memory impairment, must not be receiving any other state supplement for respite, and liquid assets cannot exceed \$50,000 for one person or \$75,000 for a couple.
